

## Certificate of Compliance

Effective May 1, 2002, the Butler County Solid Waste Commission (BCSWC) pursuant to Iowa Administrative Code Sections 455B.302 and 455B.306 requires certification for construction and demolition loads over two yards generated within the service area. Service providers hauling materials in or out of a service area are in direct violation of the comprehensive planning policy established by the Butler County Solid Waste Commission.

Any construction and demolition load of 15 yards or more must be hauled directly to the Rural Iowa Landfill and must be accompanied by the required certification. Loads hauled to the Butler County Transfer Station must also have the accompanying certification. If certification is not provided by the hauler, that hauler will be turned away from the designated facility until certification is provided and verified. A certificate of compliance is required for construction and demolition debris from each customer and will be randomly verified with that customer by the Butler County Solid Waste Commission.
